In consideration of allowing my child to participate in Skatechurch Inc activities and events (hereinafter "Sk8"), I acknowledge, understand and agree that:

- 1) The risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent disability or death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
- 2) I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES (named in # 5 below) or others, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation and for his/her wearing a helmet; and,
- 3) If, during my presence at Sk8, I observe any unusual significant hazard, I will immediately remove my child from participation and bring such hazard to the attention of the nearest Sk8 staff person; and,
- 4) I give my consent and permission for Sk8 staff to obtain any emergency medical/dental treatment for my child at any hospital in case of sickness, accident or injury and to secure such medical/dental attention at my expense whether or not my insurance applies; and,
- 5) I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Skatechurch Inc., its officers, agents, employees, volunteers, other participants, and its landlord Central Bible Church, and its officers, agents, employees, volunteers (the "RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I AM THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE ABOVE NAMED MINOR AND HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, AND HAVE EXPLAINED THE "PARTICIPANT UNDERSTANDING AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK" BELOW TO MY CHILD. I UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.

IN ORDER FOR PARTICIPANT TO SKATE/RIDE, PLEASE DO THE FOLLOWING:

1) COMPLETELY FILL OUT THE FORM ON THE BACK OF THIS SHEET.

2) READ AND SIGN THE FORM.

- Both minor participant and minor participant's legal parent (legal birth parent, legal guardian, legal foster care parent or legal adoptive parent) must sign form.
- Signatures from stepparents, host-families, grandparents, aunts, uncles, siblings, neighbors and friends are not legally binding and therefore will not be accepted.
- Parental Signatures we accept: 1. Parental signature witnessed by Skatechurch Staff, or 2. Parental signature accompanied by a photocopy of BOTH SIDES of the signing parent's valid drivers license, or 3. Parental signature witnessed and notarized by a notary public.

3) PROVIDE PROPER ID.

- Legal parents must provide current signed photo ID (Drivers license, DMV ID, or Passport).
- Minor-aged participants must provide ID to prove age/grade eligibility for the appropriate session. IDs we accept are: Current School Photo ID, Birth Certificate, Drivers License, DMV ID, Medical ID, Passport or Skatechurch ID.

4) PAY SESSION FEE TO RIDE.

5) WEAR HELMET. Those 11 or younger must wear a helmet (Peewee). Those 12 and older are encouraged to wear a helmet. Loaner helmets are available. **THOSE WHO CHOOSE NOT TO WEAR A HELMET DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. POTENTIAL INJURIES INCLUDE PERMANENT DISABILITY OR EVEN DEATH.**

6) INLINE SKATERS AND SCOOTERS ARE PERMITTED IN PEEWEE ONLY. ONLY SKATEBOARDING IS PERMITTED AT JUNIOR HIGH, HIGH SCHOOL AND OVER-18. BMX RIDERS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY SESSION.

SESSIONS:

PEEWEE	Wed. 6:30-8:30 (k-5 grade)	Those younger than Kindergarten may watch but may not participate.
JUNIOR HIGH	Mon. 6:30-9:00 (6-8 grades)	Those 15 at registration must go to High School.
HIGH SCHOOL	Tues. 6:30-9:00 (9-12 grades)	Those 18 still in High School must attend High School. Early High School graduates age 17 must attend High School.
OVER-18	Thurs. 6:30-9:00 (age 18 and graduated +)	Only those 18 and graduated from High School may attend. Those 19 must attend, even those not graduated.

NOTE:

- 1) Skaters must remain in their session through the summer until moving up when school starts.
- 2) Parents / Guardians of skaters are welcome to come and observe but they may not skate.
